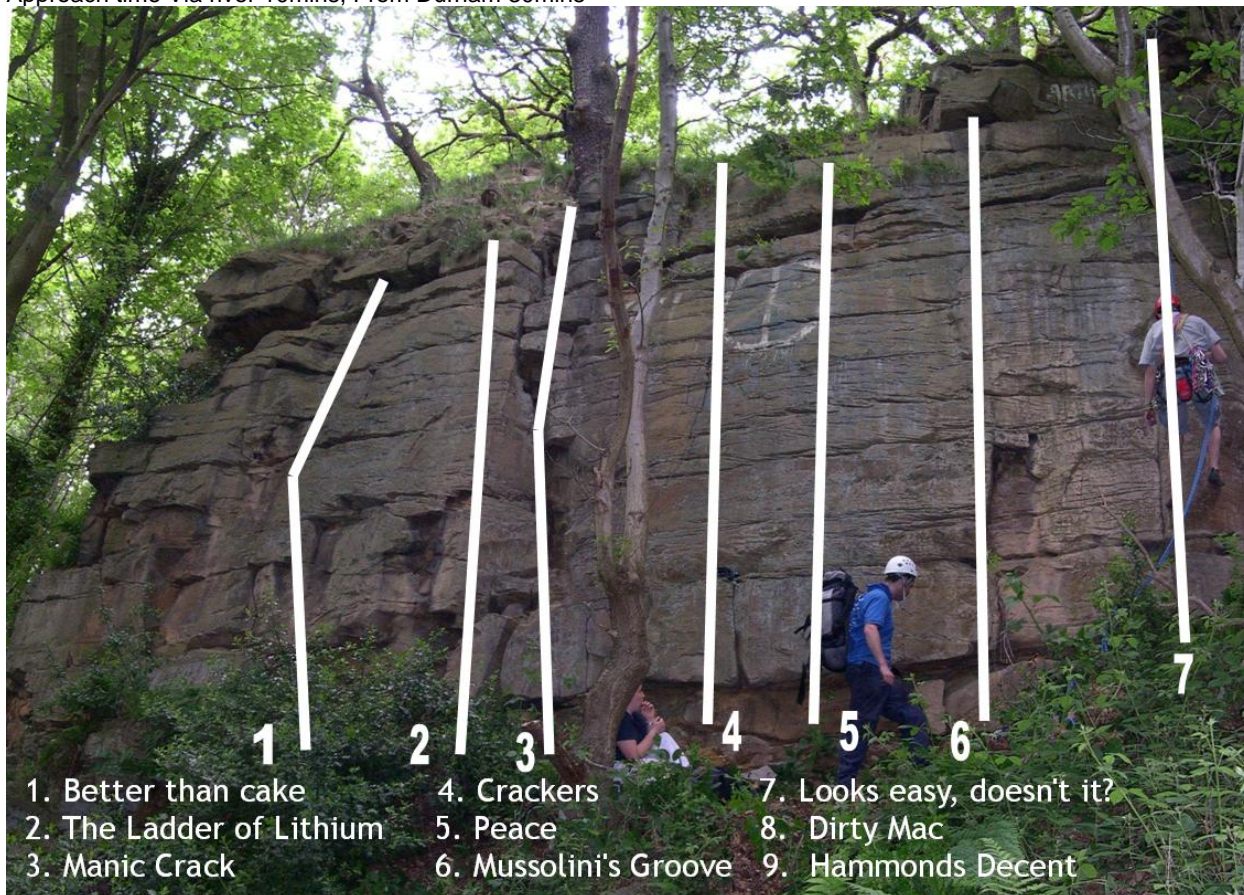


## Frankland Crag

NZ 291 441

Approach time Via river 10mins, From Durham 30mins



The crag is situated in woodland up from the wear. On reaching larger blocks next to the path head up. The first wall can be identified by the large peace symbol right of manic crack. Descent is quickest off to the right down Hammond's descent

Climbs are described left to right.

**1. Better than cake 8m S**

*Led Stephen Welch Se Mark Atkinson*

Left of the ladder of lithium, start on the broken block and ascend up the groove.

**2. The Ladder of Lithium 8m VS 4c**

*TR Stephen Welch*

The wall just left of Manic Crack

**3. Manic Crack 8m HVD**

*Led Stephen Welch Se Mark Atkinson*

Follow the prominent wide crack in the centre of the crag.

**4. Crackers 8m HS 4b**

*Led Stephen Welch Se Mark Atkinson*

Follow the thin crack line slightly left of the peace symbol

**5. Peace 8m VS 4c**

*TR Mark Atkinson*

Good holds up the blank wall through the peace symbol

**6. Mussolini's Groove 8m HVS 5a**

*TR John Yardley*

Up the short corner then groove right of peace.

**7. Looks easy, doesn't it? 8m S 4b**

*Led John Yardley Se Mark Atkinson*

Left of the arête, gain the flake to finish left of the tree.

**8. Dirty Mac 6m VD**

*Led Mark Atkinson Se Stephen Welch*

The unattractive corner left of Hammond's descent, leads to a tree which may or may not help

**9. Hammond's Descent 6m M**

*Soloed Ian Hammond*

The short corner marking the end of this wall and is quickest route of decent
